

Free 10-Minute Adventure Writing Mission

A printable sample from Pencil Passport: read the dispatch, complete one tiny writing challenge, and earn a passport stamp.

Start here: Print pages 2–4. Read the dispatch out loud, then let the child complete the writing mission at their own pace. Keep it playful and short.

What is inside this free sample

Explorer dispatch	A short letter that makes handwriting feel like a mission.
Jungle Name Trail	A 10-minute mission with tracing, copying, and one finish-the-sentence prompt.
Mini passport stamp	A quick reward moment after the mission is complete.
Parent note	Use one page at a time. This is playful at-home practice, not a clinical or school curriculum.

Jungle Trail Dispatch

Sample personalized letter using Noah as the explorer name.

Dear Noah,

Your Pencil Passport has arrived, and the Jungle Trail is waiting for a brave explorer with careful handwriting.

Today's mission is to help Ranger Ruby read the muddy animal tracks before the rain washes them away. Start by writing your explorer name, then choose one jungle animal you spotted on the trail.

Write slowly, take your time, and make each letter clear enough for the whole explorer team to read.
